

The Jan 6 pipe bomb near the RNC was planted by Dem-affiliated terrorists

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The smoking guns (executive summary)

Karlin Younger said the timer was on 20 minutes when she found the bomb near the RNC building. **This is impossible.** There was only the timer dial, which was a solid piece with a knob, and a small mechanism behind it. The time is indicated by a red arrow on the timer's body, which was removed. Without it, she could see only the knob pointing to 0 and 30. Thus, **Karlin Younger lied.** The following photos are of a similar kitchen timer, which until recently was sold by Walmart.

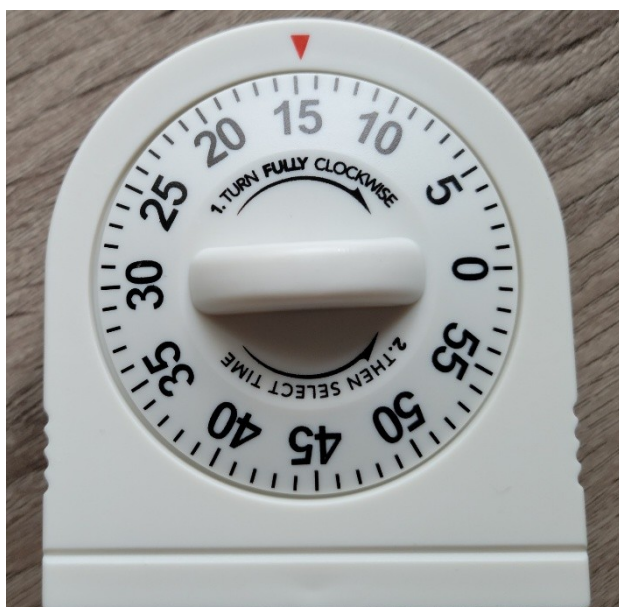


Fig. 1 (left). The timer dial. The knob is a solid part of the dial and always points to 0 and 30.

The investigation of the case was conducted by the hyper-partisan FBI WFO, headed by the infamous D'Antuono. D'Antuono is a former head of the FBI Detroit office, where he orchestrated the attempted *fednapping* of Governor Whitmer. In this case, the FBI

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WFO hid actual evidence, fabricated false evidence, invented a false story in which RNC and DNC bombs were placed on January 5, and framed an innocent person, probably a black woman. It did so to block or discourage attempts to find the actual bomber(s).

Such extraordinary protection of the actual perpetrators by the Democrat branch of the FBI indicates that they are connected to the Democratic Party.

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Introduction

Here, the term **Dems** refers to the Democrat electioneering apparatus, which is understood broadly. The famous [article by Molly Ball](#) hints at its size and sophistication. The term does not include Joe Biden, who is innocent like a child. The term does include “diversity of tactics” groups, such as [Shutdown DC and the Sunrise Movement](#). Before election day, they published maps and targeted what they called *Trump Booster locations*. The RNC was [first on their list](#).

On January 6, 2021, a pipe bomb was discovered at the RNC building and another at the DNC building, both near the Capitol, at around 12:44 and 13:07 pm, respectively ([USCP Timeline](#), pp. 11–12). Law enforcement evacuated the RNC and nearby buildings. The DNC building was NOT evacuated when a similar device was found next to it ([USCP Timeline](#), p. 14): 1330: “USCP personnel advise DNC security and Fairchild building security to have occupants shelter in place.”

The FBI claims it has not found the bomber(s) to this day and has avoided Congressional oversight on this matter. In March 2022, Representative [Jim Jordan sent a letter](#) to FBI Director Wray, in which he raised multiple questions about the FBI’s investigation into the pipe bombs, based on an FBI whistleblower’s testimony, the paucity of information provided by the FBI over a year after the fact, and its failure to sufficiently answer earlier letters from other representatives. In February 2022, Senator [Ron Jonson asked the Secret Service](#) how it could have missed the bomb near the DNC. Many more such questions have been asked and remain unanswered.

The bombs were disabled and [turned over to the FBI](#). After finding the bombs, the USCP evacuated Madison, Cannon, and Library of Congress buildings, despite no threat being presented to them by these small bombs, which had been placed far from them and behind other buildings. This disrupted RNC operations and distracted considerable USCP forces.

Karlin Younger

The “20 minutes”

RNC bomb finder [Karlin Younger said in an interview for Madison Magazine](#) (Jan 12, 2021): “I saw a tangle of wires. I looked closer and saw a six-inch pipe capped on both ends. Then I saw a timer that was stuck on the number 20. It was a radial dial.” This detail was repeated in the [Wisconsin State Journal](#) and [Washington Post](#).

The article with the interview was prepared with care, as indicated by the correction made to it less than a few hours after its initial publication: “Even though she’s **now** in D.C., Younger has **still** worked remotely since the pandemic. Her apartment is in Washington’s Capitol Hill neighborhood, just a couple of blocks from the Capitol itself.” The words in red were [added](#) to the original.

A manipulated FBI photo (see Fig. 4) was added to the relevant [FBI web page](#) after the Madison Magazine publication, likely on or around January 27 (see it [before](#) vs [after](#)).

Possible quid pro quo

In May 2021, [Karlin Younger](#) was accepted to the Defense Innovation Accelerator Entrepreneur National Security Innovation Network. In September 2021, she “graduated” from it as a co-founder of [FireFlyht](#), an autonomous navigation software firm supported by the DOD and FedTech. Nothing in her education (BA in international/global studies, master’s in comparative government) or background qualifies her for her role.

Prior suspicions

Karlin Younger’s story was suspected to be false for several reasons, from the improbable coincidence of her employment to her selection of words in a video interview. The article [The January 6 Pipe Bombs Look Like Another FBI Hoax](#) by Julie Kelly is especially helpful.

The FBI is not trying to solve the case or find the alleged suspect

The investigation has been conducted by the FBI WFO, headed by notorious D’Antuono. The FBI asked for the public’s assistance on a national level to find the alleged pipe bomb suspect (“the suspect”) but provided almost no information to help identify him/her ([video](#)).

I. Failure to provide visual information

According to the FBI, the suspect walked in one of the most heavily surveilled areas of the nation for more than 40 minutes. For most of that time, s/he would have been in view of multiple top-notch surveillance cameras. The FBI reported it had [collected over 23,000 videos](#). Some of these would have had the suspect’s face clearly visible. Yet, the FBI published only six videos, with a total length of less than 5 minutes. All these videos are grainy and/or shot from afar and/or are from angles that do not show the suspect’s face. At least one of the [FBI’s uploaded videos](#) starts and cuts with the suspect still well inside the frame. The video appears to have been cut before the suspect can be better seen.

The FBI provided just enough videos to show that the suspect acts suspiciously and carries a backpack but carefully avoided showing anything that may help identify the suspect.

II. Failure to provide descriptive information

The suspect walked in a populated area and encountered multiple people. The FBI reported it had interviewed [more than 800 witnesses](#). Even in the cherry-picked videos provided to the public, the suspect had a face-to-face encounter with a local man walking his dog.

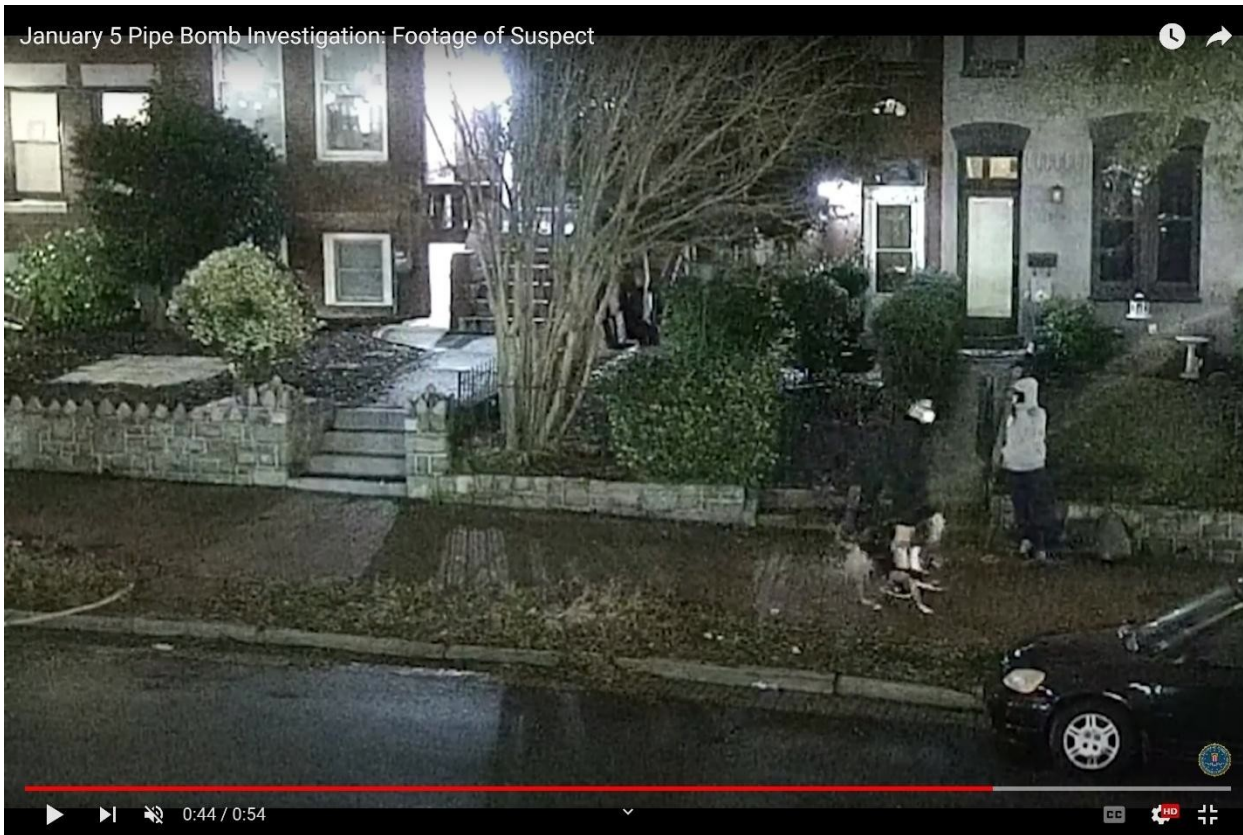


Fig. 3. The alleged suspect (on the right) meets a local man walking a dog.

Interviews with these witnesses should provide a rather detailed description of the suspect. Additional information can be obtained by [forensic image analysis](#). The FBI is more than capable of determining the height, weight, gender, age, shoe size, and other characteristics of the suspect. This information should have been sufficient to find the suspect in such a high-profile case. Yet, the FBI has neither found him/her nor provided this information to the public.

III. Manipulated photo conceals that the dial is a single solid piece

Both bombs were equipped with a dial mechanism from a basic mechanical kitchen timer. The timer mechanisms are in FBI possession.

The FBI's picture of the timer dial (Fig. 4) appears manipulated to create the impression that the knob is separate from the dial, can rotate relative to it, and can point to any number. This suggests that some FBI operative(s) recognized the fatal discrepancy in the words of Karlin Younger and fabricated evidence to conceal it.

III. Failure to use the information from the dial mechanism

[D'Antuono asked the public to report individuals](#) who have *unexplained possession of multiple kitchen timers*, where *multiple* includes two. A kitchen timer is a common item, and millions of households have two or more of them. But if the FBI wanted to find the suspect with this approach, it could provide the make, model, and pictures of the timers used in the bombs. A picture of the same or a similar timer type is above. The product information for this timer is on the back of its packaging.

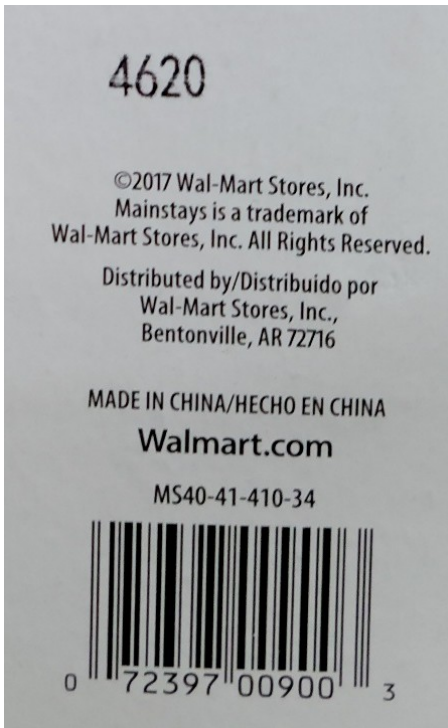


Fig. 6. Print on the back of the timer package.

Because it is a Walmart brand (see www.AcuRite.com), this type of timer might be unique to Walmart. If so, one can attempt to determine the batch, where and when it was sold, and so on.

Note that the FBI described the alleged suspect's sneakers in detail, although (or because) the sneakers' look, brand, and model provide practically useless information. Hundreds of thousands of people own such sneakers.

IV. Mobile device

The official suspect appears to use a mobile device. The FBI should have obtained its data from the cell network operator, Google, and/or social media companies, but it has remained moot on this point as well.

V. D'Antuono history

Steven D'Antuono, CPA, Assistant Director in Charge of the FBI WFO (i.e., head of the WFO), is responsible for the investigation of the pipe bombs. He was appointed to his current position on [2020-10-13](#) by FBI Director Stephen Wray. This appointment occurred immediately after D'Antuono supervised the entrapment of several people in a fictional plot to kidnap Democrat Governor of Michigan Gretchen Whitmer. This [plot](#), almost entirely organized by the FBI, was "revealed" prior to the 2020 elections and presented as an instance of far-right extremism to influence the election in favor of the Democrats. This demonstrates D'Antuono's extreme Democrat partisanship and professional misconduct in the pursuit of partisan goals.

It also perfectly matches his behavior in this case and the politics of the Biden administration. D'Antuono provided practically no actual evidence or leads but called on citizens to report their friends and relatives if they had "*an increased fixation on the current political climate, unexplained possession of multiple kitchen timers, or any emotion you feel is inappropriate.*"

More contradictions in the FBI's story

I. The bombs could not have been planted before January 6

The bombs had a timer with a maximum delay of one hour. They could not have been planted on the previous day if they were intended to explode. Even if not intended to explode (the most likely case), bombs planted on January 5 were likely to be found that night or early the next morning. January 6 was an unusually busy day, and people were likely swarming around the DNC and RNC buildings.

Also, Kamala Harris entered the DNC around 11:30 am on January 6, and thus the area had been [swept by the Secret Service](#) beforehand. The DNC bomb was [placed openly near a park bench next to the DNC](#), visible to pedestrians and passing vehicles. The bomb was not found by the Secret Service because it was not there at the time of the sweep.

The bomb placed near the RNC was in the garbage disposal area of the Capitol Hill Club and would have been found by its employees the previous night or that morning. If Karlin Younger found the bomb at 12:40 pm, there were many people in the area who would have found it much earlier.

II. The movement of the suspect is incompatible with the theory that s/he planted the bombs

None of the published videos show the alleged suspect carrying or planting a bomb. Revolver News has shown that the [DNC had a video showing the suspect](#) in the moment s/he could have planted the bomb. This video is missing. This suggests DNC complicity.

The walking distance from the DNC to the RNC is 0.2 miles, or about 5 minutes. The [FBI's animated map](#) starts tracking the suspect at some point close to halfway between the two buildings. The suspect would have needed only about 7 minutes to visit both buildings. So why would s/he spend more than 40 minutes in the most surveilled area of the nation on a day of heightened security? Why would a bomber stick around for another 20 minutes after placing a bomb?

Conclusion

Thus, the FBI WFO seems to have presented the public with a fake story and a fake suspect. As good liars, they provided minimum relevant details.

The only reason for such behavior would be to protect the real bomber(s). Given the prior partisan conduct of the head of FBI WFO, D'Antuono, the conclusion is that the actual bombers were affiliated with the Democratic Party.

Even if the devices were not rigged to explode, as seems to be the case, the presence of explosives is sufficient for determination that a device is a live bomb. The act of planting a bomb near the RNC and/or DNC building is a terrorist act.

Curiously, the office of Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez looks straight at the Capitol Hill Club – RNC building complex.

What might have really happened – an educated guess

The RNC was expected to have a “war room” to watch for Democrat provocations, to keep independent communication channels open between President Trump, his advisers, and Congressional Republicans, etc. Dems wanted to disrupt RNC headquarters on January 6 during the critical period from 1 to 4 pm.

One of the many Dem-affiliated militant groups accomplished this. Somebody placed a pipe bomb near the RNC on Jan 6 just before 12:40 pm and asked or led Karlin Younger to find it. This resulted in the RNC evacuation, thus achieving the objective. To divert suspicions from the Democratic Party, the same group placed a similar bomb near the DNC just before it was “discovered” at 1:07 pm. The DNC building was not evacuated.

Another possible goal of the Capitol breach planners was to distract the USCP force from defending the Capitol building, as [Chief Sund said](#). If so, this goal was achieved.
